CF Foundation Finest Honorees show exemplary leadership, are active in their communities, and excel in their profession or business. Honorees commit to raising a minimum of \$3,500 in support of vital cystic fibrosis research, participate in monthly education networking events (including a CF Care Center tour and lecture at the Children's Hospital of Richmond at VCU), and are then recognized at our annual Richmond Brewer's Ball event. In its 11th year, the Richmond's Finest campaign has raised \$1,175,776, thus far, to support the mission of the CF Foundation.





OUR WHY

Cystic fibrosis is a progressive, genetic disease that causes a thick buildup of mucus in the lungs, pancreas, and other organs and affects people of every racial and ethnic group. In the lungs, mucus clogs the airways and traps bacteria, leading to infections, extensive lung damage, and respiratory failure. People living with the disease face significant challenges, including frequent hospitalizations, complications, and treatment plans that can take multiple hours a day.

Recognized globally, the Cystic Fibrosis
Foundation has led the way in the fight
against cystic fibrosis, fueling extraordinary
medical and scientific progress. Despite this
progress, many people with CF do not
benefit from existing therapies. Many
children and adults with CF still face the
sobering prospect of a shortened lifespan.





THE IMPACT

Working alongside the CF community, the CF Foundation drives extraordinary results. We have more than doubled the life expectancy of those living with CF over the past three decades by funding high quality, specialized care and therapeutic programs. We have provided more than 4,000 grants for CF research and care over the past six years. We established a globally recognized care model that includes 120+ accredited CF care centers across the country - two in Richmond! We supported pioneering research that led to the discovery of the gene that causes CF in 1984. Today, we have engaged with more than 50 biotech companies in the U.S. and Europe to advance gene-based therapies. We launched the Therapeutics Development Network which is THE model for research networks globally. We pioneered the use of venture philanthropy - a model that is admired and emulated by nonprofits everywhere for its astonishing capacity to drive results. We fostered the development of more than a dozen CF treatments and added DECADES of life for those with CF. We champion policies to protect the CF community and advocate for high-quality specialized care for people with CF and their families. We will not leave anyone behind!
